Personality

More about pink

Pink is the soft colour, often seen as the 'baby' colour. Maybe because the colour of the womb is soft pink and it is the place where we normally experience unconditional love, care and warmth. Pink cells are still used worldwide in prisons to calm down violent inmates within minutes. Pink has a soft, gentle and comforting effect on us and can therefore be used to divert violence or confrontation. There is a relation between babies and pink, both vulnerable, soft, gentle, loving and a need for care. Pink is also a feminine - creative colour. The feminine and possibility of creation can be linked with the menstrual cycle of women. Women who have just given birth or who are in the menopause, often have a tendency to overdose on pink. They can feel vulnerable because it is a beginning (birth) of a new cycle and need this colour for support and care.

After 9/11 I noticed that men in particular started to wear more pink shirts. Men are expressing their creative and 'feminine' side more than ever. (not all men!)

Pink is related to childhood, being a child or behaving in a



childlike manner. People who do not wear or like this colour often have unhappy childhood memories or unresolved emotional issues with their parent(s). This can indicate that they were not allowed to be a child or behave in a child-like manner, innocent and vulnerable.

Not wearing or liking pink can also indicate that the problem is not with the parents but with parenting. It can give an indication that there have been difficulties conceiving or that there have been parenting problems with one or more of their children.
