



More about purple

Purple is a combination of red and blue. Red is a so-called warm colour and blue is a cool colour. Therefore, the colour purple can be perceived as either a cold or warm colour; reserved as well as sensitive; delicate yet impressive.

In ancient Rome, only the Emperor and his Imperial family had the right to wear purple clothing. The Emperor Nero even punished offenders with the death penalty for wearing it. Maybe for this reason the colour purple was associated with supreme power in cultures from Persia to Israel. It took about 10,000 molluscs (murex shells) to make one gram of dye, which made the colour purple an expensive dye. Vitruvius said, "it is the most precious and the most pleasing to the eye". When the Roman Empire crumbled, some of the dyeing techniques were lost. However, in the 4th Century the use of purple became in



fashion again with royalty and Catholic traditions.

The colour purple is still seen as a 'royal' and spiritual colour. However, wearing too much of this colour can give an impression of aloofness and arrogance.

Purple is the colour of spirituality, creative energy and inspiration and therefore many artists and visionaries love to wear this colour as it connects them with the universal energy. This colour can unify the body and mind with spirit, calm your nerves and enable you to receive spiritual or artistic inspiration.

Purple food has a purifying, diuretic and sedative effect on the human body. Purple foods are eggplant, purple grapes, purple broccoli, purple onion, plums, beets and purple cabbage, lavender, purple sage and thyme. All these foods have a healing effect on all forms of neurosis and neurotic manifestations.
